The value, duration, and the number available	One bursary available with a minimum \$5,000 annual payment for the duration of the recipient's undergraduate program while residing at Duchesne College.
Description	This Bursary aims to support a female resident who because of their own personal circumstances, without the support of this bursary would be unable to reside at Duchesne College, and therefore unable to pursue tertiary education at a Queensland-based university campus in Brisbane.

Eligibility criteria	<p>To be considered for The Reverend Mother Joan Percy-Dove Memorial Bursary applicants must be a new resident and who meet the below criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Accepted into a full-time undergraduate program which includes a placement course, or• Accepted into the Provisional Entry pathway for the Doctor of Medicine at UQ, for the duration of the undergraduate pathway program, and the duration of the postgraduate Doctor of Medicine at UQ, or• Accepted into the undergraduate medicine program at UQ, and• Is from a regional or rural area of Australia, as defined by the Australian Government Rural, Remote and Metropolitan Area classification, with preference given to QLD applicants, and• Has experienced personal circumstances that impacted on her most recent studies and access to educational opportunities. <p>Preference will be given to applicants who are not in receipt of any other Duchesne College scholarships or bursaries.</p>
Selection process	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Applications must be submitted by the closing date with all relevant supporting documentation.• A selection committee, to be determined by the Head of College, will review all applications and present a short list and recommendation to the Head of College for approval.• The Head of College will inform the College Council and seek their endorsement of the recommendation.• The Head of College will inform the Catholic Foundation, Archdiocese of Brisbane of the outcome so that the bursary can be awarded.• All applicants will be notified in writing of the outcome of their applications.
Conditions	<p>It is a requirement for all bursary and scholarship recipients;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• to remain enrolled full-time in their program of study• to achieve a minimum passing grade in each course of study (GPA of 4.00 out of 7.00), and
