Eligibility criteria	To be considered for the Duchesne College Council Bursary applicants must: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be able to demonstrate financial hardship or a change in financial circumstances• Intend to reside at Duchesne College• Intend to enrol in full-time studies at a Brisbane tertiary institution• Demonstrate a commitment to the College's ethos and values• Be an Australian citizen or permanent resident.
Selection process	Selection is through a transparent and proper process: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Records of all decisions made throughout the selection process are appropriately kept.• Eligible applicants are screened and shortlisted by the Selection Panel.• Shortlisted applicants will be invited to an interview.• Successful applicants will be notified in writing.
Conditions	It is a requirement for all bursary and scholarship recipients to remain enrolled full-time in their program of study, to achieve a minimum passing grade in each course of study (GPA of 4.00 out of 7.00), to contribute to college life and a commitment to the ethos and values of the Duchesne College.
